Install system smoke detectors located at bottom of the roof deck on the gym side of each of the 2 windows in the gym.

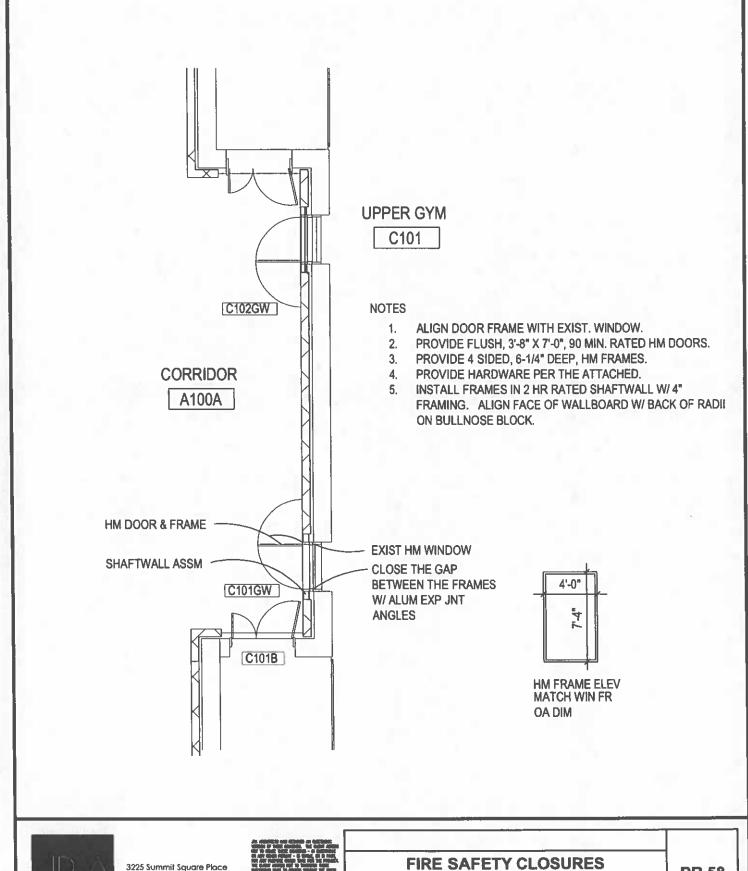
