BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The KDE has a process allowing for a shortened day for students indentified under IDEA. An ARC team recently met to discuss the need to shorten the school day for a student.

SUMMARY OF MAJOR ELEMENTS:

The Admission and Release Committee (ARC) has approved a shortened day for one student at Huntertown Elementary. The shortened day is due to extensive interventions needed during the afternoon block due to increased aggression and dysregulation. This shortened day will promote the student's attendance, and support the student's ability to attend to tasks and self-regulate, with fewer interventions.
