Whereas, the Board of Education of Woodford County has been approached by residents of the Legends subdivision adjacent to Southside Elementary School regarding the opening of walkable access between the Legends Subdivision and the Southside Elementary School campus;

Whereas, the Board wishes to be presented with and examine a proposal for the safe opening of walkable access between the Legends subdivision and Southside Elementary School campus;

Therefore, it is RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Board directs the Superintendent to work with appropriate staff, including but not limited to the Chief Safety Officer, to develop and present to the Board for consideration a plan and proposal for opening walking access between the Legends subdivision and Southside Elementary School campus, including any improvements, structures, gates, lighting, pathways, or other elements to be added to or constructed around the entrance. The proposal should also include the estimated cost of those improvements.
- 2. The proposal should include the elements needed to open and provide walkable access between the Legends Subdivision and Southside Elementary School's campus in a reasonably safe fashion as determined by the Chief Safety Officer.
- 3. The Superintendent may present multiple options for walking access between the Legends subdivision and the Southside Elementary School campus to the Board for the Board to consider.
