01.1 Legal Status of the Board

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

KCSD has handheld radios at every building. Due to aging systems and equipment, it is necessary to rework some of the buildings and campus to increase coverage. The radios are utilized for daily communication between staff and available for school leadership during emergencies. The new FCC license is needed to isolate the schools from each other. Previously, there were shared frequencies but with the newer technology, these frequencies have begun to overlap other buildings. The radio systems are school level obligations with the support of the District Operations Team.
