01.1 Legal Status of the Board

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

KCSD currently provides an opportunity for up to 10 high school students to participate in an eight-week summer technology work-based learning (WBL) program in partnership with the District's Technology team, referred to as KCTWI Phase I (Kenton County Technology Work Initiative). This program, created in April 2022, was expanded from six to eight weeks in May 2023. The Technology team requests to continue Phase I into the Summer of 2024 and going forward as aligned with the KCSD Technology 1:1 program previously approved. KCTWI Phase I Interns will be paid under the recently approved (May 2023) Student Intern Job Description as Step 0 from G1 pay scale.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

Approximately \$45,000 (ARP ESSER and/or General Fund)
