The Franklin-Simpson Board of Education Scholarship is made available by the Franklin-Simpson Board of Education.

Purpose: The FSBOE scholarship program is designed to encourage and support outstanding students who work hard, have financial need, <u>desires to enter the education field</u> and who plans to attend a post-secondary institution who exemplifies the Franklin-Simpson High School motto "Focus, Spirit, Honor, Success."

Administration: The Franklin-Simpson Board of Education will administer the scholarship to two recipients. The scholarship amount shall be \$750 to each student payable upon graduation from FSHS. In the event there is only one applicant for the scholarship, the Board of Education will award a scholarship in the amount ranging from \$750-\$1500. This is a one-year only scholarship. CHECK WILL BE WRITTEN TO COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY in name of recipient.

Eligibility

Demonstrated scholastic ability with a minimum 3,0 unweighted grade point average.

- Extracurricular involvement including leadership positions held. Please include schoolrelated
 - activities, work experience, community activities and volunteer experience.
- Demonstrated commitment to academic excellence by attendance record of at least 90% during first
 - two grading periods of senior year. Year end attendance must also be 90%.
- 3. Financial Need.
- One letter of recommendation: from a faculty/staff member at FSHS. Letter of recommendation should demonstrate how the applicant exemplifies the qualities of FSHS- Focus, Spirit, Honor and Success.

Selection:

- 1. Students will apply for the scholarship through the guidance counselor's office.
- 2. Students will complete scholarship application and return application, along with the letter of recommendation from a teacher and transcript to the guidance office by <u>April 15th at 12:00 p.m.</u>
- 3. The BOE will review and discuss all applications.
- 4. The BOE will select finalists. These finalists will be interviewed by the BOE. A BOE member will contact finalists regarding their interview times and location.
- 5. Scholarships will be awarded at Senior Awards Banquet.
