<u>AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM)</u>: Consider/Approve 2025 Supplemental and Miscellaneous Salary Schedules

<u>APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY</u>: 03.121 and 03.221 Salaries

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

Annual review of the 2024 Supplemental Salary Schedules reveal that KCSD leads in the region and Kentucky. The district is fortunate to be able to offer compensation that ranks among the very best in the region and state as the labor market tightens.

Recognizing the accomplishments and hours of dedication to KCSD student extra and cocurricular activities as well as the continued inflationary economic conditions, the 2025 Supplemental and Miscellaneous Salary Schedules reflect a 5% increase over last year.
