Over the last 3 years, situations and variables have altered the plan for our consolidation of Hopkinsville High School and Christian County High School multiple times, leading to changed paths for academics as well as athletics. This is evident by our 2023 request to move CCHS from 5A to 6A in order to prevent multiple disruptions in our opponent's schedules. Now that we have a definite consolidation date, 2026, we can focus on providing the best environment and opportunity for our outgoing Jrs and Srs. Our request is two-fold in its reasoning.  1. We feel it is vital for our last HHS Sr class to be in a FB class that allows them to be competitive and experience the opportunity to earn advancement in the 4A playoffs. Memories will be made and we are just sincerely asking that our HHS FB players and staff be given chance to play at a level of competition that those memories are a reachable possibility.  2. Scheduling  a. The current proposed alignment has HHS in a 6A 4-team District for 2025 and 2026. By removing HHS from 6A-District 1, it will create a 3-team District—the same District that will exist in the 2026 season. This will allow teams in this District to create a schedule that will be uninterrupted by consolidation since Christian County High School is one of the three District teams. CCHS would need only 1 game to complete its 2026 regular season schedule.  b. If HHS were to be moved to 6A-District 1, it he difficulty of creating a 2025 regular schedule could be insummountable. Even with the planning of a Bowl game, the last CCHS vs HHS FB game, and two District games, we will still have to schedule 6 games on a one year contract. By keeping HHS in 4A-District 1, with the exitof HHS, they will only have to find four teams to complete our 2025 regular season schedule. Please understand, we are also keeping in mind

I am writing this letter to you on behalf of Daviess County High School pertaining to the redistricting of the 6A football alignment beginning the year 2025-2026.  We would like to appeal our placement in this redistricting process. We have been placed in 6A District 1 and would like to be placed in 6A District 1. Our reasons for this appeal are as follows:  1) By being placed in District 2 that causes travel distance/time and logistical issues with transportation. Two of our three district opponents would now be in a different time zone than us.  a. Our bus situation does not allow our teams to leave before 4:30 PM CST. We then have to travel 90 minutes and into EST zone for the games. That puts us arriving to those schools at 7:00 PM local time. To safely prepare mentally and physically for the game it is a 60 to 90 minute process pre-game. That pushes game time to 8:00 PM to 8:30 and that is depending on everything going smoothly with travel.  2) By being placed in District 1 we eliminate the time issues with everyone being in the CST zone. This also puts us with the teams that we have been District rivals with for many years. We have been natural District rivals with McCracken County since their school originated. These very competitive games become difficult to keep with our new alignment.  3) We are aware that moving to District 1 would make that a five-team district and make District 2 a three-team district for possibly one year. When Hopkinsville and Christian County merge then that would put District 1 back to four teams.  Thank you very much for considering our appeal in this situation.
