Academics

MAP Growth from 2022-2023 school year to 2023-2024 school year:

MATH:

2023-2024 Fall to Spring, 61% of our Kindergarten - 5th grade students met or exceeded their MAP math goal set by NWEA.

2022-2023 Fall to Spring, 41 % of our Kindergarten- 5^{th} grade students met or exceeded their MAP math goal set by NWEA.

READING:

2023-2024 Fall to Spring, 60% of our Kindergarten – 5^{th} grade students met or exceeded their MAP reading goal set by NWEA.

2022-2023 Fall to Spring, 44 % of our Kindergarten-5th grade students met or exceeded their MAP reading goal set by NWEA.

PLCs

- We have completed four PLC/Essential Standards training sessions with Dr. Mandy Barrett from Solution Tree. We have gained a deeper understanding of the grade level standards and the PLC process.
 - Each grade level has identified 5-8 essential math standards.
 - The next step will be to align and discuss the standards vertically
