Academics

MAP Growth from 2022-2023 school year to 2023-2024 school year:

**MATH:**

2023-2024 Fall to Spring, 61% of our Kindergarten - 5<sup>th</sup> grade students met or exceeded their MAP **math** goal set by NWEA.

2022-2023 Fall to Spring, 41 % of our Kindergarten- 5<sup>th</sup> grade students met or exceeded their MAP **math** goal set by NWEA.

**READING:**

2023-2024 Fall to Spring, 60% of our Kindergarten – 5<sup>th</sup> grade students met or exceeded their MAP **reading** goal set by NWEA.

2022-2023 Fall to Spring, 44 % of our Kindergarten- 5<sup>th</sup> grade students met or exceeded their MAP **reading** goal set by NWEA.

- **PLCs**
  - We have completed four PLC/Essential Standards training sessions with Dr. Mandy Barrett from Solution Tree. We have gained a deeper understanding of the grade level standards and the PLC process.
    - Each grade level has identified 5-8 essential math standards.
    - The next step will be to align and discuss the standards vertically
    - We will then continue the work of unpacking the standards, creating learning targets and aligning appropriate assessments.
    - We will move to ELA standards when math is complete
- **Read to Succeed**
  - After researching and studying samples of *Amplify*, *Wonders*, *Into Reading* and *Wit & Wisdom*, teachers have selected **McGraw Hill -Wonders** for our new ELA resource. (Dependent on BISD Board Approval)
  - 1 teacher has completed the first year of LETRS training
  - 9 teachers are interested in beginning the next LETRS cohort

Through this process.....

  - Teachers intentionally providing more independent writing time
  - Student writing work is displaying frequently
  - Teachers have a deeper understanding of the importance of students knowing the finished product and seeing distinguished examples
  - Less of a need for supplemental materials
  - Students have intentional writing practice each Friday

  - We utilize students' academic, social and emotional data to determine student needs, scheduling, intervention and class lists for next school year.
