



See below as a follow-up:


Approval for lowering the MH on the Northeast elevation. – WE are good with this direction and have forwarded that recommendation on to Cate.

Moving the stage in the rear wooded area Northwest to allow for better drainage and installing a new swale around the edge to help create positive drainage. – See sketch below. We discussed pushing the classroom space northward to take advantage of the existing berm. Mulch pathway to adjust accordingly. Connection to north from classroom circle to be omitted to stay out of flowing water of unknown origin in that area. Retain the existing gate/fence as currently located. Small berm to be added north of the walkway to divert water towards the fence gate. Establish a small swale far enough into the area to provide for positive drainage around the classroom area, and overseed following regrading.

Raising the detention area to allow the system to work properly due to solid rock 18" above planned subgrade.

We are looking at either raising the detention up or enlarging and shallowing up the detention area. This is pending engineering calculations. Will follow up ASAP.
