- UPDATE LANGUAGE AS NEEDED TO REFLECT CURRENT MISSION AND VISION, GOALS.
- CONSIDER AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHANGES TO PROCEDURES.
- · COHERENCE: POLICY, PROFESSIONAL LEARNING, COMMUNICATION

OVERVIEW COMMITTEE PROCESS

- + DISTRICT COMMITTEE, COMPRISED OF TEACHERS (JCTA IDENTIFIED), PRINCIPALS, AND DISTRICT LEADERS, MET FOUR TIMES TO REVIEW AND REVISE THE PROCEDURES IN THE SPP AND ALGF BASED ON THE WORK OF LEVEL SUBCOMMITTEES (ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE, AND HIGH).
- + Committee Members established a 3-Year Goal and Timeline to shift toward Standards- and competency-based grading with a national facilitator.
- + Level subcommittees met to gather input from stakeholder groups, then review and revise procedures and determined recommendations for the District committee to consider and adopt.
 - COMMITTEE MEMBERS CONDUCTED A REAP AND MADE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHANGES BASED ON THE OUTCOME.
