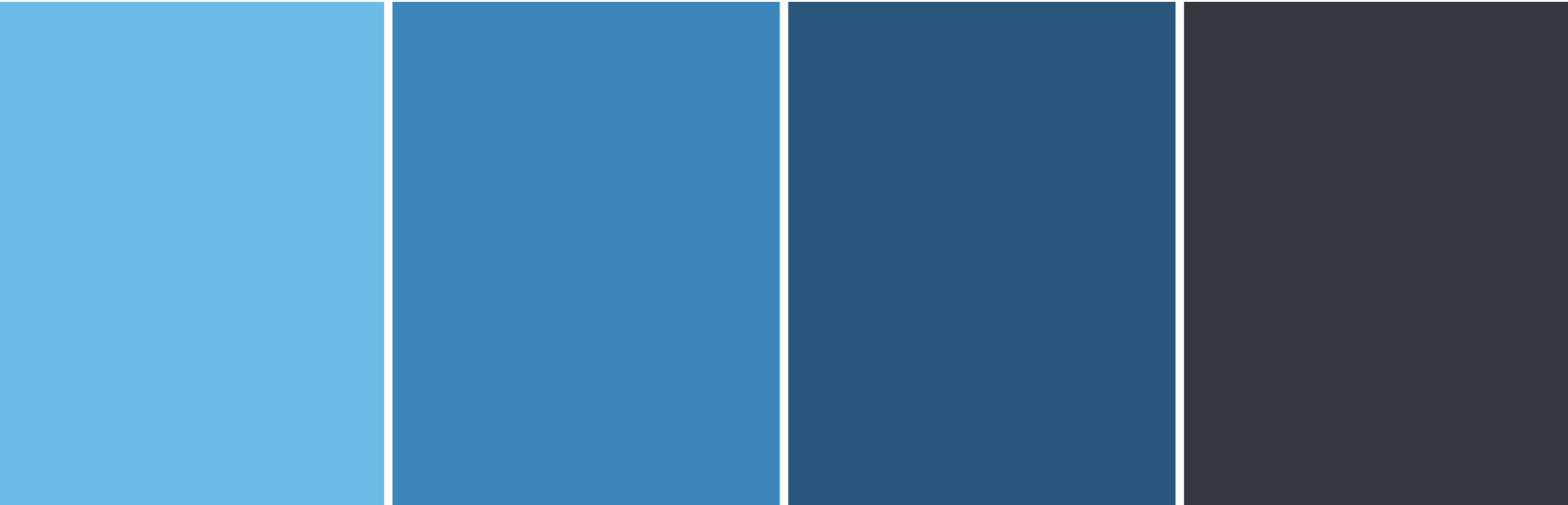




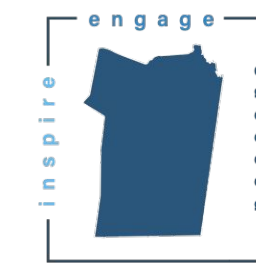

- 15 - Full time School Resource Officers on Campus (Increase of 2)
- 15 State risk assessments completed this year in each school facility
- 15 GRREC Volunteer safety assessments completed this year in each school facility
- Safety Drills - Every School in compliance or exceeds expectations
- Volunteer audits completed in March at both middle schools by KCSS to assess all areas for continued improvement
- New Weapons Detection System implemented at middle schools now used in 5 locations CCMS, HMS, CCHS, HHS & Bluegrass

## New Procedures

- Gatekeepers trainings at all schools
- Internal Safety Audits - 3 visits at each school with a differentiated checklist

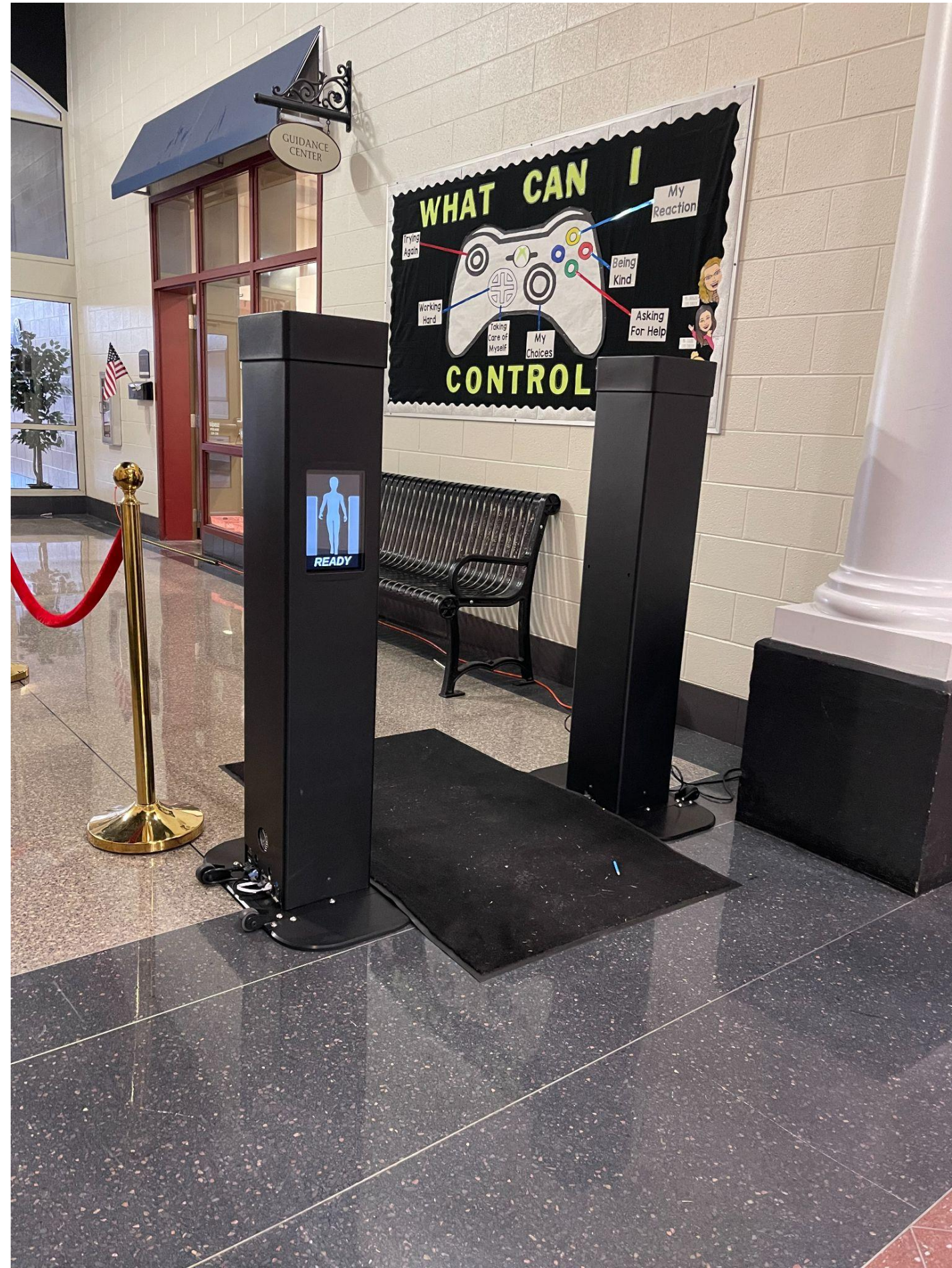
