I am requesting approval of an out of state trip request for the Powell County Bass Team to travel to the World Finals / National High School Bass Fishing Championships on June 15-23, 2024 in Anderson, South Carolina. Transportation will be provided by parents and/or boat captains and lodging, as well as meals, will be handled and paid for by the parents.

My plan is to pay each student, boat captain and coach a stipend amount from the Bass Team account to help with the costs of this trip. My goal is to give each person \$400.00 towards food, gas / fuel, fishing supplies (if needed) and meals. We currently planned multiple fundraisers to help with the funding of this trip for the kids and boat captains. We recently held our annual fish fry at the high school and are currently operating the high school softball concessions. However, because the softball team had some games cancelled and the fact that this season the softball team has played most of their games on the road, we are requesting some financial assistance for our trip. Due to the fact that no one on the team qualified for State this year, saving the district several thousands, we are requesting the amount equivalent of a head coach's salary of \$2,500.00. I currently don't receive a stipend as a head coach. I strictly volunteer my time just because of this reason. Our fundraising efforts fell short for the year, therefore we are requesting some financial assistance to help our team.

We currently have 8 anglers that will be entering into the World Finals portion of the tournament. Three of our high school teams will be qualified in May to advance to the KY SAF Team Trail Fish-Off to see who advances to the National Championships portion of this dual tournament. The Nationals is an invitation only tournament and you receive that invite by placing in a designated top percentage in certain tournaments; the SAF Kentucky State Championships and our current trail series, KY SAF Team Trail, which we are competing in now. My middle school kids are eligible to enter into the World Finals as well after their graduation date from 8th Grade.

Fish Limits

Largemouth, Smallmouth, Spotted, Redeye, 12" and over

Anglers are allowed to weigh a limit of three (3) fish per team unless otherwise required by law or tournament officials.

Fish presented which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented that is determined to be non-releasable.

Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty. Anglers are required to have a valid South Carolina fishing license/ permit, if applicable by law.
