**SUBJECT:** Director of District Data and System Efficiency

**DISCUSSION:**

The duties of maintaining various student/assessment databases have increased and changed significantly. With the increased need for importing and exporting various forms of assessment data (Career and Technical Education data, KEES Scholarship data, Dual Credit Scholarship data, I-Ready Diagnostic data, State KSA data, etc), the district is recommending that we approve a Director of District Data and System Efficiency position to better meet the needs and responsibilities of organizing, maintaining, and sharing the data at the district and state levels. This certified position would require a valid Kentucky teaching certificate and a K-12 administrator certificate. The position will be 7.5 hours per day, 240 days per year with an \$11,428 increment. The funding for this position will be general funds.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

I recommend the Hardin County Board of Education approve the creation of the Director of District Data and System Efficiency position.
