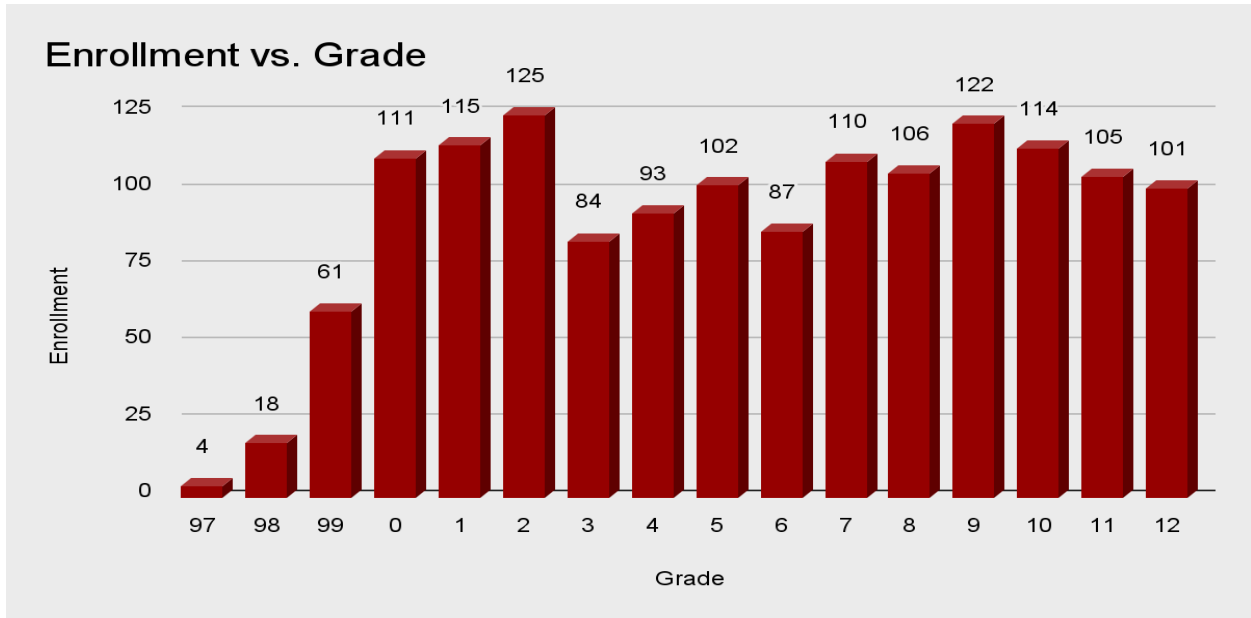

Enrollment

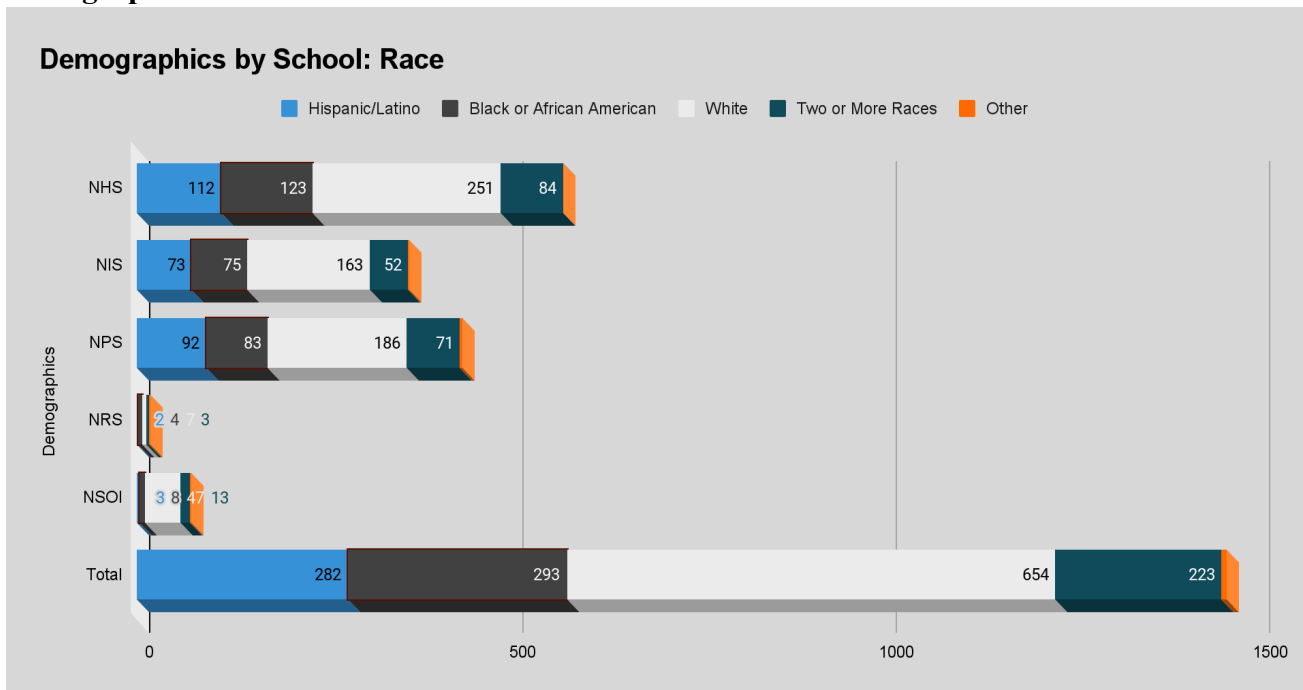
Enrollment at Newport Independent Schools on May 16, 2024 was 1459.

Demographics

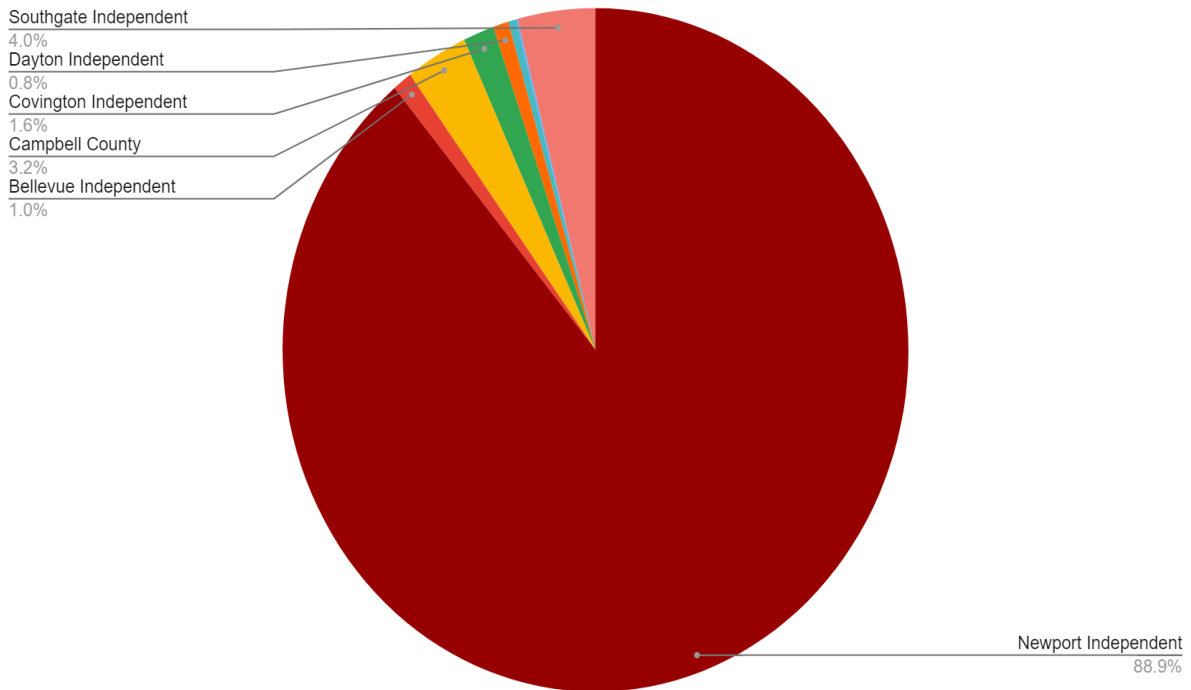

Federal Programs

Title I, Part A

As a local education agency, Newport Independent continues to encumber federal program funds to meet the 85% obligation as planned by each Title I school within the district. During the months of May and June we will be focusing on new resources released by KDE related to school level parent and family engagement policies and the school family compacts. Each school will complete their needs assessments during leadership retreat in June.

Title III and English Language Learners

ACCESS score reports for individual students have been received. We will be providing these to families and reviewing scores with each to ensure appropriate planning for student success in the 2024-2025 school year. Full data will be published with the School Report Card in the fall of 2024.

Extended School Services & 21st Century

Summer school will be held in each school location: Newport Primary, Newport Intermediate, and Newport High. Dates of Summer School are June 5, 2024 through July 3, 2024. We will observe Juneteenth on June 19, 2024. Each school has identified staff who are committed to providing summer learning to students. Schools have also identified and continue to invite students to summer programming. Initial criteria is set for: 21st Century participating student, ESS participating student, student in Tier II or III for reading and/or math, student failing one or more classes, and students who have been identified as chronically absent.
