- 20 Students with A/B Honor Roll (28%)
- 12 Students we considered Most Improved (17%)
 - Most Improved is determined by a student that:
 - Struggles at the beginning of the year but turns it around and keeps pushing forward, This could be improvement with grades and or progress.
 - Students whose work ethic changed from one school year to the next.

Graduation Rate since opening NSOI:

- 2019-2020
 - 100% Graduation Rate of 18 students
 - 4 of the 18 were early graduates
- 2020-2021
 - 100% Graduation Rate of 13 students
 - 5 of the 13 were early graduates
- 2021-2022
 - 100% Graduation Rate of 11 students
 - 2 of the 11 were early graduates
- 2022-2023
 - 100% Graduation Rate of 14 students
- 2023-2024
 - 95% Graduation Rate of 21 students
 - 1 student turned 18 stopped working may drop out
 - 1 student graduated as a junior
