

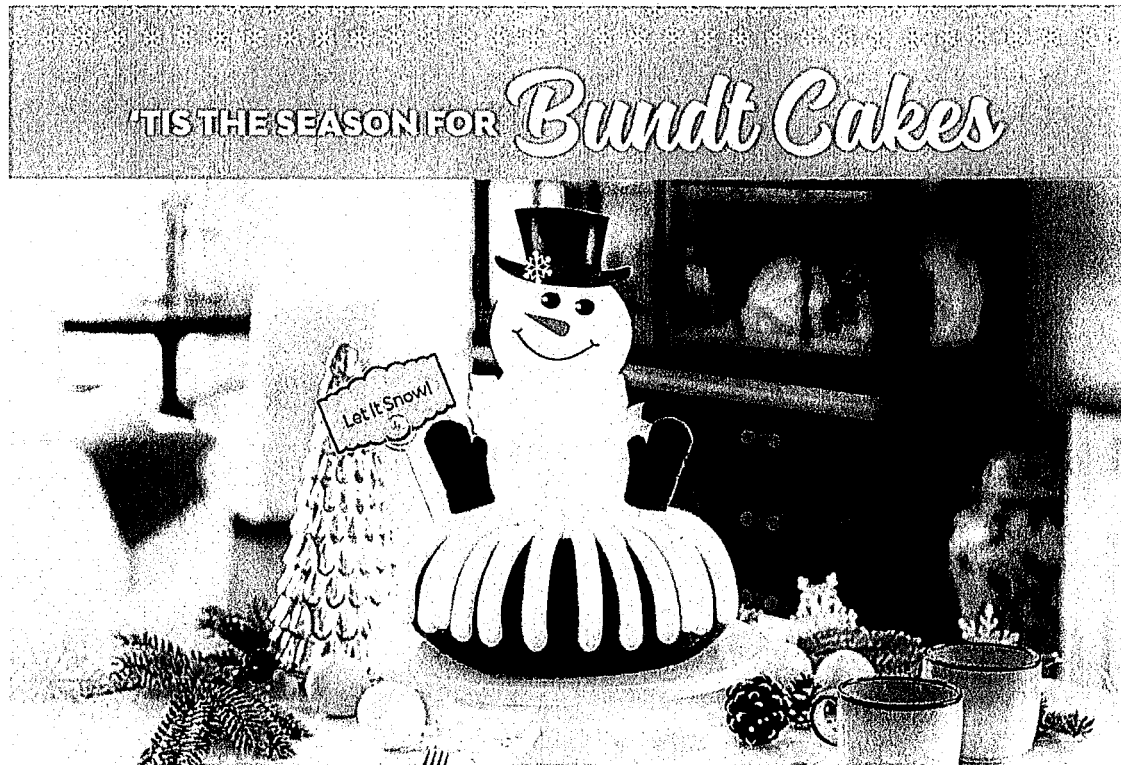

Thank you for your interest in our fundraising program. We would love to work with your group to raise funds!

Our fundraising program is similar in setup to selling Girl Scout cookies. We send you the order form, you sell bundtlets to family and friends, and you will profit per bundtlet sold. When the ordering period has ended, you will turn the forms into us at the bakery. We "sell" you the bundtlets, or fill the order, for \$5.00 per bundtlet. You will sell the bundtlets for \$7.00 each.

Depending on the size of the fundraiser, our typical turn-around time is about 14 days. We will have you sell for about 2 weeks, and then give you a 1-2 day window to gather your paperwork and to get your totals counted. **All fundraisers are packaged by flavor and sorted by your group after pick up.** If you would like to proceed in scheduling a fundraiser with us, please respond with 2-3 potential pick up dates.

****Our dates are booked on a first come first served basis. Once we confirm dates, we will send over a Fundraising Agreement Form that must be completed prior to securing your spot on our calendar. If you turn in your totals later than your agreed upon turn in date, we reserve the right to push your pick up date back.****






