

Paint Your Spot Fundraiser

- This school year we are offering only the Seniors the opportunity to paint their own parking spot.
 - This means they would have their own, personalized parking spot for the entire school year.

How It Works:

- On the Class of 2025 Google Classroom, there will be a Google Form (Paint Your Spot Registration form) that you will need to fill out and hand in with your Parking Permit packet.
 - You must come in and purchase your parking spot permit at Open House on _____, August ____ (date?) between 4-6 PM. This is the ONLY time the spots are guaranteed to be sold. You will be shown a diagram of the parking lot and will choose your parking spot from what is available. There will be no switching of spots once chosen.
 - Fee: \$50-cash or check made out to ACSHS Student Government Association.
 - Once you have been assigned your spot, you can come time between hours of 7 AM and 7 PM to paint; you will have until _____ to paint your spot; once painted, it cannot be changed (unless deemed necessary by administration).
 - This money will go toward Senior class activities, including, but not limited to, Class Night, the Senior field trip, et al.
 - All other ACSHS parking spot rules and guidelines still apply for the entirety of the school year.

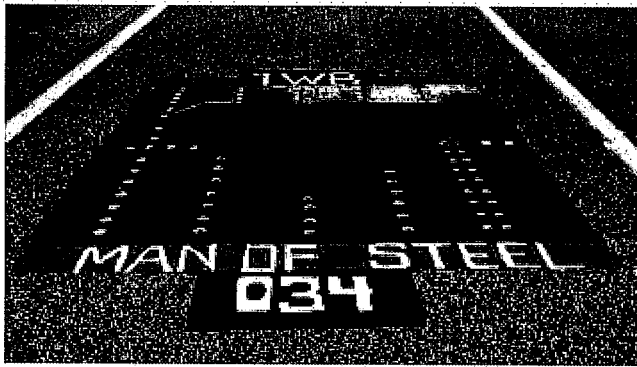
RULES for Painting Your Spot:

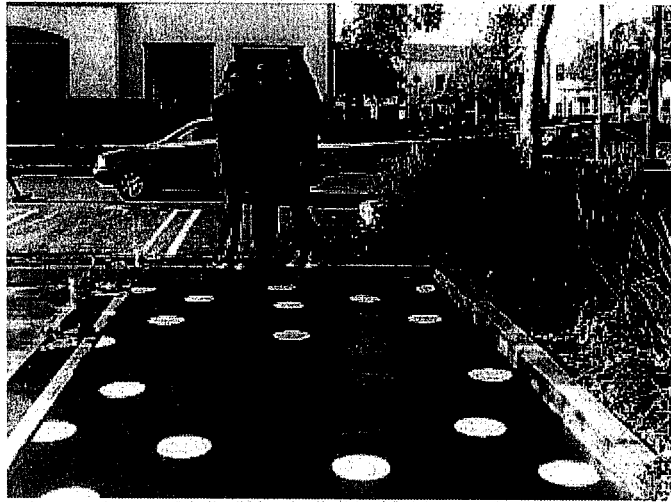
- Use the template provided to chalk in your paint area and create a 4 inch border from all white lines and 4 inches above your parking spot number.
- Paint with any household interior or exterior paint. Water based-latex paint works the best.
 - Other paints such as garage/cement paint will work as well. •
- No fluorescent or spray paint is permitted.
- DO NOT PAINT ON ANY CURB that is attached to your space and keep your paint inside your own spot!
- Make sure that whatever you paint is school appropriate and has been preapproved (by attaching the image/sketch to your Google Form submission).
 - If it isn't, the school WILL paint over your spot in black and it will remain black for the entire school year.
 - Moreover, you will NOT receive a refund.
- Please take care of all of your painting supplies when you are done.
 - DO NOT leave any paint cans or trash on the parking lot!
 - Do not use the restrooms to clean out brushes or wash your hands.
 - Have everything that you will need (wipes, baggies, cups, etc.) on site.

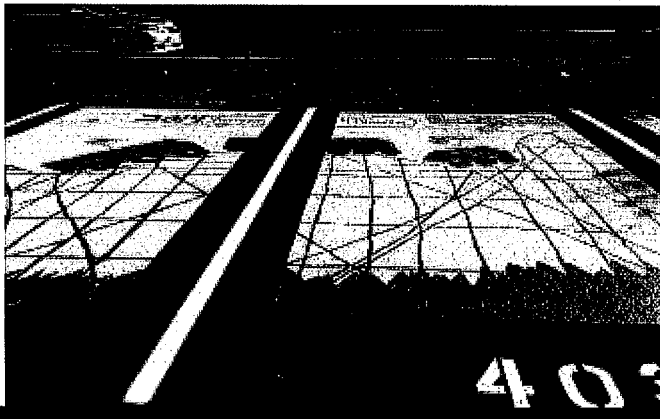
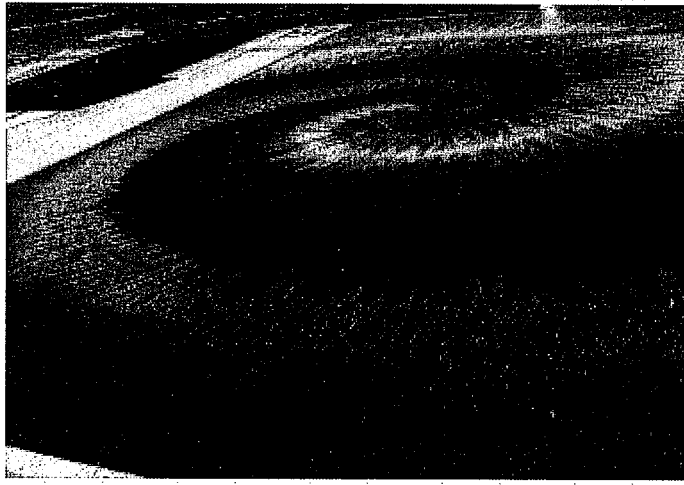
- If you create a barrier around your spot while it dries to keep foot traffic out, do not use paint cans.
- Return a few hours later to pick up your barrier.
- If you make a mess, CLEAN IT UP!
- Do not splatter paint on your spot. It will make a mess and will be hard to clean up.
- ANYONE NOT FOLLOWING THESE RULES ARE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$10+ AND/OR having their spot repainted!

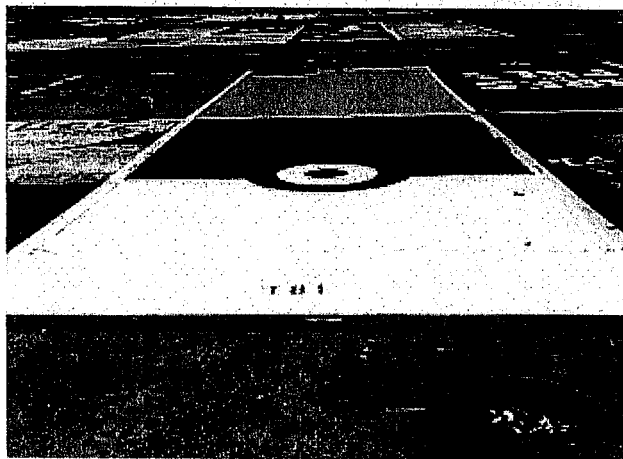
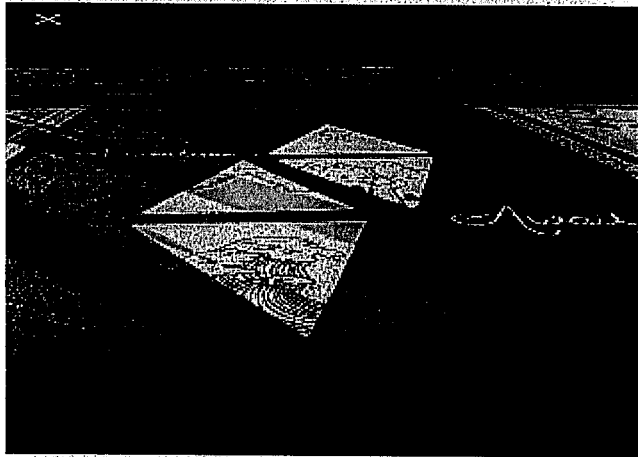
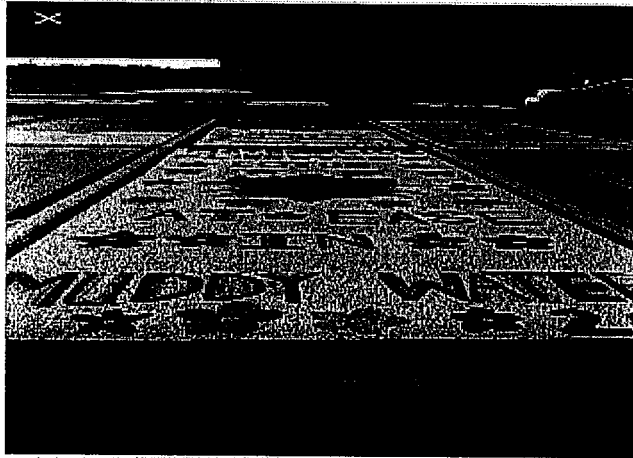
Tips for Painting Your Spot

- Paint can be expensive. Ask family, neighbors, and grandparents if they have any paint lying around that they aren't using. You can usually get it tinted at the hardware store.
- Hardware stores usually have paint in the clearance section of custom colors that people ended up not using. These paints are deeply discounted.
- Talk to your friends about what colors they are using and then go into together on the paint.
- Simplify your design = more colors, more money.




