RE: Title 1 funds for MTSS Coach Extended Days for the 2024-2025 school year

REQUEST:

With the release of the 2022-23 KSA scores, ELS data, administrative and instructional walkthrough data (focusing on our every student, every day expectations and ELEOT), and Professional Learning Community team data we recognize an imminent need for additional focus on both academic and behavioral instructional practices. I am requesting an additional fifteen extended contract days for the MTSS Coach position for the 2024-25 school year to support planning to strengthen, and implement high leverage instructional practices, authentic learning experiences and RTI opportunities aligned with the vision of BCPS and NBHS. The result of increased contract days will allow for administrative collaboration in planning for teacher support and implementation of district and state level deeper learning initiatives to increase proficiency amongst students.

The cost of this position would be \$ 6, 225.72.
