RECRUITMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM

Hopkins County School personnel who recommend a new school Bus Driver, Custodian, Vehicle Mechanic I, or Maintenance Worker II; who is hired and works for one complete year in the same position as a Bus Driver (including training time), Custodian, or Vehicle Mechanic I, or Maintenance Worker II will receive a \$500 bonus. Upon completion of one year, the Bus Driver/Custodian/Vehicle Mechanic I/Maintenance Worker II will receive a \$1,000 bonus. All bonus payments will be processed at the end of the completed year. It is the responsibility of any employee who is eligible for either of these bonuses to notify Human Resources before the new bus driver/custodian initial hire date.
