

The teams will be staying in Florida the entire week playing games and/or practicing everyday except one which will be a relaxing day to enjoy the beach and do some sight seeing. The team will return to Kentucky April 8th, departing at approximately 9:00 A.M. and arriving back at John Hardin at approximately 7:00 P.M.


