PLE Archery- Eli Lamb: 2024 NASP IBO 3-D Elementary Boy Champion

Eli Lamb competed in the NASP Archery Championship Tournament in June with his Paint Lick Elementary School Archery Team. This competition in Daytona, Florida brought the top archers from all over the country together to compete in the Bullseye and IBO 3-D competitions. In both competitions, archers shoot 6 arrows in 5 rounds of shooting for a total of 300 points possible. Eli shot an impressive score of 289 in the IBO 3-D Competition earning him the title of the 2024 NASP IBO Elementary Boy Champion. The title was achieved by Eli shooting 19 of his 30 arrows as perfect bullseyes ultimately placing him in first place out of 242 elementary boy archers. Eli's win in the IBO 3-D Championship makes him the first elementary school archer from Kentucky to ever earn the title since this competition began in 2015. Additionally, Eli had a great performance in the Bullseye competition as well. He shot a score of 285 which earned him a 3rd Place finish for the Elementary Boys Bullseye Competition.
