Recommendation/Motion: To approve the agreement with AVID Center for the 2024-2025 academic school year.

Background/Rationale: Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) is an in-school academic support program to prepare students for college eligibility and success. AVID was implemented as a pilot during the 2023-2024 academic school year at Morton Middle, Bryan Station Middle, Lafayette High, and Bryan Station High, and will continue at a greater degree of implementation (school-wide) during the 2024-2025 academic school year. AVID provides scaffolded support that educators and students need to encourage college and career readiness and success. The implementation impact will promote additional students in AVID programming to enroll in more rigorous courses and achieve at high levels in those courses.

Data Considerations: By 2025, Fayette County Public Schools will increase the Post-Secondary indicator score to 87.3. Currently, the level is 79.5.
