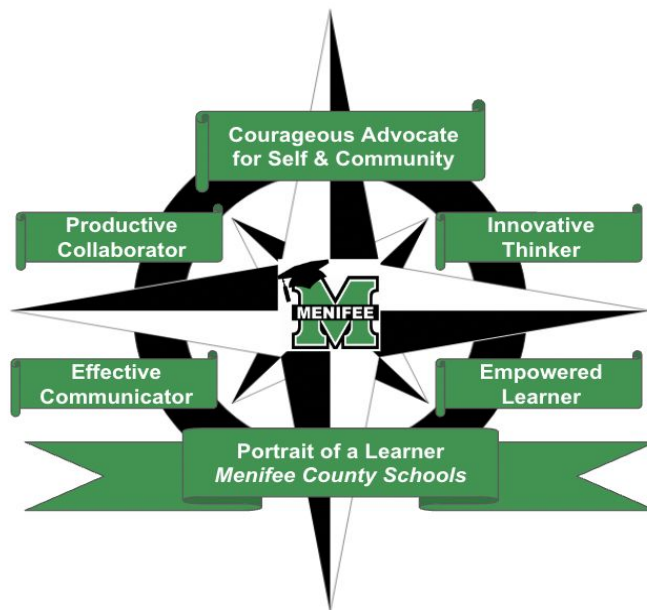

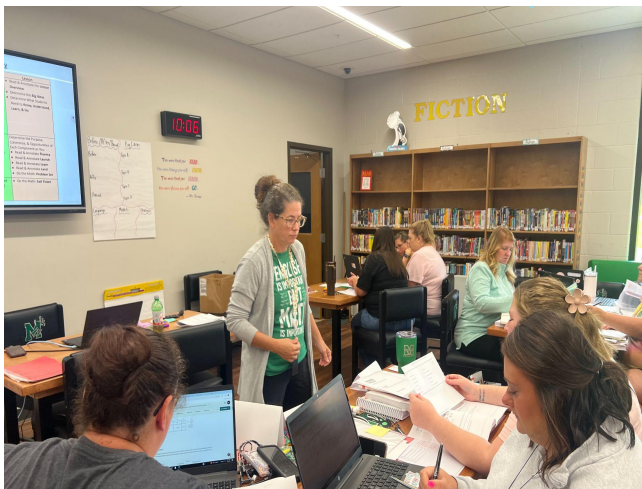
Navigating with Purpose: A Pathway to the Future

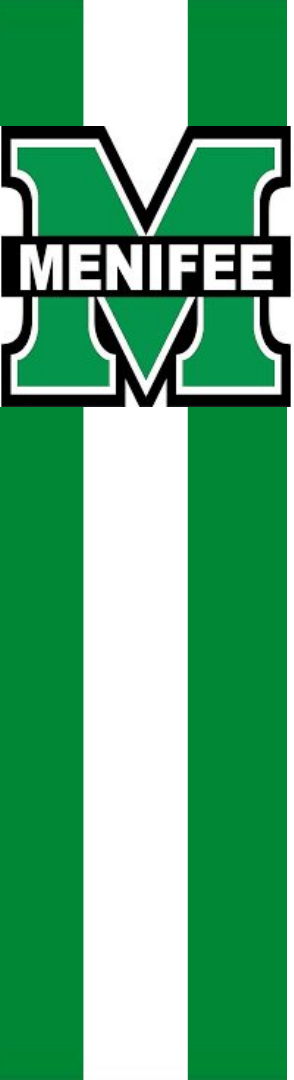




Menifee County High School Instruction/Progress Monitoring
