# Why is the price changing?

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- Reimbursement Rates
- Value of Donated Foods/Commodity Rate

## Adult Meal Prices for Non-Pricing Sites

Breakfast Formula	Example
Current USDA Free Breakfast Reimbursement Rate	\$2.37
Bonus Reimbursement: Severe Need Differential	\$0.47
Current Value of Donated Foods/Commodity Rate	\$0.3000
<b>Minimum Adult Meal Price Required</b>	<b>\$3.14</b>
Suggested Adult Breakfast Price (Rounded to the nearest \$0.05)	\$3.15

## Adult Meal Prices for Non-Pricing Sites

Lunch Formula	Example
Current USDA Free Lunch Reimbursement Rate	\$4.43
Performance Based Reimbursement Rate	\$0.09
Bonus Reimbursement: Lunch Safety Net	\$0.02
Current Value of Donated Foods/Commodity Rate	\$0.3000
<b>Minimum Adult Meal Price Required</b>	<b>\$4.84</b>
Suggested Adult Lunch Price (Rounded to the nearest \$0.05)	\$4.85

# Our Adult Meal Prices

	Breakfast	Lunch
Current Adult Meal Price:	\$ 3.05	\$ 4.65
New Proposed Price:	\$ 3.15	\$ 4.85
Overall Increase:	\$ .10	\$ .20

# Formula to Approve

$$\begin{aligned} & \text{USDA School Meal Program in Operation} \\ & \text{Reimbursement Rates} \\ & + \\ & \text{Value of Donated Foods/Commodity Rate} \\ & \hline & \text{Minimum Adult Meal Price} \\ & \text{(Rounding Up is Optional)} \end{aligned}$$
