JCPS TRANSPORTATION OVERVIEW

Routes per each tier: 526

Total number of JCPS bus drivers: 580

Total number of JCPS bus routes (highest tier/total): 526

Routes covered after daily absences: 528

Additional buses = overload/ McKinney Vento/ far away school choice, to improve service, etc.

Ridership was reduced by approximately 14,000 students. Last year, we had on average 74 uncovered routes. This equates to roughly 13,500 riders daily we could not accommodate.

Today, we are functioning within drivers available to routes needed.

2021-22- first day clear at 7:30pm




CAR RIDER/TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS


