HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

Students who use or possess smoking paraphernalia (jules or other vapor products) will have the items confiscated as noted in KCSD Code of Conduct and Expected Behavior 2024-25. NKY Health will provide a vape disposal program that includes education materials and resources, supplies for proper disposal of vapes by school staff, training on handling devices, and picking up disposed of vape devices. The KCSD will not participate in the use of optional anonymous vape disposal containers.

This memorandum of agreement sets forth the responsibilities of the parties and the terms and conditions of the agreement established for the collaboration of the vape disposal program. This agreement is effective September 10, 2024. Neither party shall have any financial obligation to the other resulting from or relating to this agreement.

The First Party agrees to:

- 1. Provide all participating schools within the Kenton County School District with a brief training on the NKY Health Vape Disposal Program.
- 2. Provide all participating schools within the Kenton County School District with the necessary supplies for the NKY Health Vape Disposal Program.
- 3. Visit all participating schools within the Kenton County School District every three months or as needed to check the vape disposal bins. If bins have reached the 2.2-pound fill line, NKY Health will properly dispose of vapes, and line disposal bin with a new bag.

The Second Party agrees to:

- 1. Participate in a brief training on the NKY Health Vape Disposal Program with NKY Health's tobacco team, and notify NKY Health when a new employee needs to be trained.
- 2. Implement at least one tobacco education program identified in the toolkit to all students each school year; and complete the required Tobacco Education Google form.



- 3. Optional installation of vape disposal container(s) in a locked cabinet in a location determined by the school that allows for anonymous vape container disposal if approved by the school Board.
- 4. Contact the NKY Health's Tobacco Team when the vape disposal bins reaches the 2.2-pound fill line.
- 5. Document confiscation of vapes and any other tobacco products using survey.
- 6. Display tobacco cessation banners at all school and sporting events.
- 7. Add tobacco education during initial announcements at all school and sporting events.

Neither party shall assign its duties and obligations under this agreement without prior written consent of the other party. Any subcontract entered by the Second Party as the result of this assignment shall mandate that the subcontractor is required to abide by the same statutes and regulations regarding agreements listed above.

The term of the agreement shall be for a period from the date of its execution and shall be reviewed annually. Subject to such revisions as are mutually agreeable at the time of annual review, the duration of the agreement shall be continuous unless termination as specified within this agreement.

The agreement may be terminated by either party at any time if the other party defaults in any material obligation, but only if such default shall have continued for a period of thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice thereof by the other party. Either party shall have the right to terminate this agreement at any time, with or without cause, by giving 30 days written notice to the other party.

Ditch Vapes: NKY Health's Vape Disposal Program

Due to the nicotine cartridges and lithium-ion batteries found within vaping devices, they are considered a "P-listed hazardous waste" ("an especially acute hazard when disposed of as hazardous waste") and are subject to the Resource Conservation Recovery Act (RCRA). The RCRA is a federal law that requires specific handling for certain hazardous waste products³. According to the Energy and Environment Cabinet Department for Environmental Protection (2021), public schools "have responsibilities to ensure that the vaping devices are handled and disposed of in a way that is protective of human health and the environment" (please see last page of toolkit to review full memo).

Vape Waste Disposal Kit Supplies

Your school will receive:

- Sharps containers (disposable bins)
 - o Three per school
- (Optional) Lockboxes (for sharps containers located inside bathrooms)
 - o Two per school
- Nitrile gloves
- Trash bag liners (used to line sharps containers)
- Vaping posters
 - Two per school

- Vaping resources
- Tobacco cessation banners
 - o Five per school

Vape Waste Disposal Set-Up

- One of the sharps containers will be used for confiscated vapes, and should be stored inside a locked administrative office that does not have student access.
- (Optional) Two of the sharps containers will be placed inside of lockboxes. These lock boxes will need to be mounted on the wall inside one female bathroom and one male bathroom near the cafeteria or gymnasium.
 - A vaping poster should be placed on wall above each of the mounted lockboxes.
- Tobacco Cessation banners should be hung up at locations where sporting events are hosted (e.g., Fence at football field, fence at baseball field, inside gym for basketball games, etc.)




Best Practices: Safe Handling, and Disposal of Vaping Devices

- When handling vaping devices, please use nitrile gloves to limit your exposure to harmful chemicals. Place vaping devices, components, and e-liquid into designated sharps container.
 - If device is leaking, please put on nitrile gloves, place vaping device into a plastic bag, remove gloves and place into plastic bag, seal the bag, and place into disposal bin.
- Once the bin has reached the 2.2-pound fill line, please call NKY Health's Tobacco
 Prevention Health Educators at (859) 363-2092. The NKY Health's Tobacco Prevention
 Health Educators will come to your school, empty the disposal bin, and take the contents
 to a recycling center. The NKY Health's Tobacco Prevention Health Educators will be
 coming to your school quarterly to check each disposable bin.


BIG TOBACCO SPENDS MILLION EACH DAY IN MARKETING
