- Includes unexcused days and unexcused check-in/out (no more than the equivalent of 7 days missed)

- No more than TWO office referrals documented in Infinite Campus per year

### COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION

- Serve the community by helping someone, agency or neighborhood. Cannot help family members in your own home. Must be 2 hours total (K-2) and 4 hours total (3-5) (can be multiple projects). Fill out [volunteer service form](#) and get parents to sign it AND turn it in ON Time
- School/Community Team/Individual Sport
- School/Community Extracurricular Activity

### GRADES (3-5 ONLY)

- At least a cumulative C average with no failures

## Menifee Central → Grades 6-7

### ATTENDANCE

96% attendance

- Includes unexcused days, and unexcused check-in/out (no more than the equivalent of 7 days missed)

### BEHAVIOR

- No more than TWO office referrals documented in Infinite Campus per year

### COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION=

#### Participate in any Two

- School/Community Team/Individual Sport
- School/Community Extracurricular Activity
- Complete work-based learning experience such as internship, mentorship, service learning, or entrepreneurship.
- Complete 6 hours of volunteer service. Fill out a [volunteer service form](#) and get parents to sign it AND turn it in ON Time.

### GRADES

- At least a cumulative C average with no failures

## Menifee County High School → Grades 8-12

### ATTENDANCE

96% attendance

- Includes unexcused days, and unexcused check-in/out (no more than the equivalent of 7 days missed)

### BEHAVIOR

- No more than TWO office referrals documented in Infinite Campus per year

### COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION=

#### Participate in any Two

1. Organized team or individual sport at MCHS
2. Extra-curricular program or club at MCHS or community-based
3. Part-time employment working a minimum of 8 hours a week for 2 consecutive months
4. Complete 10 hours of community service OR complete a community service/volunteer project. Fill out a [volunteer service form](#) and get parents to sign it AND turn it ON Time.

### GRADES

- At least a cumulative C average with no failures

**Senior Workplace Ethics Seal on Diploma** = The requirements are to achieve a Badge every year through the ACEs Career Navigator Program in grades 8-12. Senior students who have achieved this Badge all 5 years of high school will receive the Workplace Ethics Seal on their High School Diploma.



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
