Change Order Description And Justification

Proposal 1 - There was an area that required additional clearing to allow for new construction

to proceed. ADD \$8,920.

Proposal 2 - The proposed water meter and valve were shown to be installed under Phase 2 but it was determined it had to be installed under Phase 1. ADD \$4,408.

Proposal 3 - During excavation, it was discovered that an additional 40' of 12" pipe was needed since the end of the existing storm network was further south than initially thought. ADD \$3,036.

Proposal 4 - There were numerous arears of soft soil below the old road that were required to be removed and recompacted to allow for proper pavement support. ADD \$33,558.

Proposal 5 - When Phase 1 was bid it was expected that the existing pump station would be demolished; however, after negotiations failed on the gravity route it was decided to keep the existing pump station so the existing station needed to be refed with electric. ADD \$17,905.

Proposal 6 - It was determined to add two pull boxes and conduit to run under the new Army Reserve Road to allow for new electric over to the new parking lot. ADD \$6,250.

Proposal 7R - Once the drilling operations started for the piles of the new retaining wall, one of the areas required a additional/deeper pile due to lower than expected bedrock. The special inspector verified this extra depth was required. ADD \$8,106.

Cost Benefit To Owner

Proposal 1 - The additional clearing allowed for the new construction to proceed as planned.

Proposal 2 - The water meter and gate valve comply with NKY Water District and will allow for water service.

Proposal 3 - The extra length of storm piping allows the network to be completed as intended

Proposal 4 - The subgrade was compacted as recommended by the special inspector which allows the pavement to last as intended.

Proposal 5 - The existing SD1 pump station will have permanent electric relocated and hooked back up so operations will continue as required.

Proposal 6 - The new conduit will allow for electric at the new parking lot for events.

Proposal 7R - The extra pile allows for the new retaining wall to adequately hold back the existing hillside.
