All students entering the clinical area have completed the following requirements. If a student does not meet a requirement they will not be permitted to enter the clinical area unless an exception is approved by the Clinical Facility.

1. Immunizations

- a. Hepatitis B: (series of three injections: #1 on day of injection, #2 twenty-eight days after the first injection, #3 four to six months after the second injection. Vaccination series are not to be started over if too long between injections (e.g. started hepatitis B #1 on March 1, 2017; not getting #2 until present-will start with #2 on Feb 1, 2018 and get #3 injection 4-6 months after second injection)
- b. Tdap: one time dose is necessary and Td (tetanus booster) will occur every 10 years after. Td does not count for this vaccination; if Td is given a Tdap will still be necessary
- c. Varicella: If positive chicken pox disease, need to document appropriate month and year. If no history of chicken pox-need 2 varicella vaccines, at least 28 days apart
- d. MMR: 2 documented MMR vaccines

- e. PPD/TB Skin Test: Annual QuantiFeron Gold or T-Spot required
- f. Influenza/Flu: required annually.
- 2. CPR: Current American Heart Association Basic Life Support for Health Care Providers Certification
- 3. Criminal Background Check: all students complete a background check upon entry into the program from Castlebranch. Students are issued a card with personal identification which enables clinical facilities to access individual background checks. Students are prepared to provide their individual cards at the clinical facilities' request(s).
- 4. Drug Screen: students are required to complete a drug screen upon entry into the program that screens for the following: amphetamine, barbiturates, benzodiapines, cocaine, marijuana, methadone, opiates, phencyclidine, propoxyphene and methaqualone.
- 5. Verification of Liability Insurance.
- 6. Verification of Personal Health Insurance
