2024-2025 school year.

Background/Rationale: The ACT assessment measures high school student's general educational development and their capability to complete college-level work with multiple choice questions in four skill areas: English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science. This contract is for Grade 10 only. The state provides the ACT assessment to all students in Grade 11 (Spring) and in Grade 12 (Fall) as a part of our district's accountability.
