Recommendation/Motion: A motion is in order to approve the Pearson contract for the 2024-2025 school year.

Background/Rationale: This contract is a renewal of the scope of work for year 3 with Pearson. The Pearson Assessment Delivery and Management (ADAM) platform provides rigorous, standard-based assessments for students in Grades 3 – High School. District Content and Assessment Instruction Specialists, along with Teachers provided feedback for each assessment to Pearson. Our schools receive each assessment prior to the unit of student to plan collectively in grade-level and content PLCs. The scope of year 3 work includes assessments in the following content areas: Algebra I, II, Geometry, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, English 1-4, Government/Civics, U.S. History, World History, and On Demand Writing in November and March.

Data Considerations: The data reporting suites in Pearson provides schools with an aggregate and performance report. Both reports identify standards-based analysis, standard and skill misconceptions, and performance of school, grade-level, class, and individual students.
