Background/Rationale: This educational trip aims to provide fourth-grade students with an immersive historical experience in Jamestown, Williamsburg and Yorktown, Virginia. Through interactive activities and guided tours, students will gain a deeper understanding of early American history, colonial life, and the significance of these historic sites in shaping the nation.
