Recommendation/Motion: Authorize the Superintendent to execute a contract with CMTA, Inc. in the amount of \$124,850.00 (One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand, Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars) to perform the commissioning services outlined below, subject to review/approval of the FCPS General Counsel.

Background/Rationale: Even when new building systems are installed properly, the question remains whether these systems are performing at the optimal and most energy-efficient levels. Building commissioning attempts to ensure that the building's mechanical/plumbing/electrical systems and components not only meet Owner's operational objectives but are also conserving resources and cost. Similar to Special Inspections, the use of facility commissioning has grown rapidly and is part of the building code requirements of the 2012 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) and the 90.1-2010 American Society of Heating, Refrigerating, and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE). The project engineer has provided a written scope of work for the fundamental commissioning (related to HVAC, plumbing, and lighting control systems) required by IECC for this project, as well as building envelope performance testing.

Five (5) commissioning agents were contacted (RFP #44-24) and one proposal was received for this project. Based on the design team's analysis of the proposal received, CMTA, Inc. appears to have met all of the project scope of work criteria and has submitted an acceptable and cost-efficient proposal. The total anticipated value of the services (\$124,850.00) needed for the project requires the approval of the Board.
