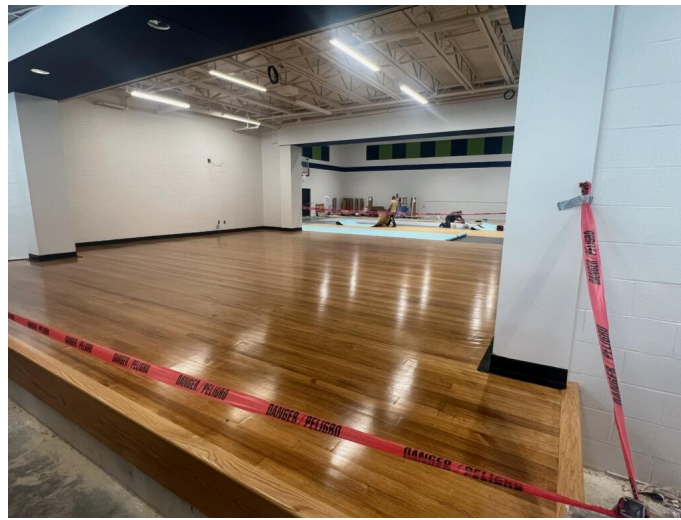

# Peak Moments



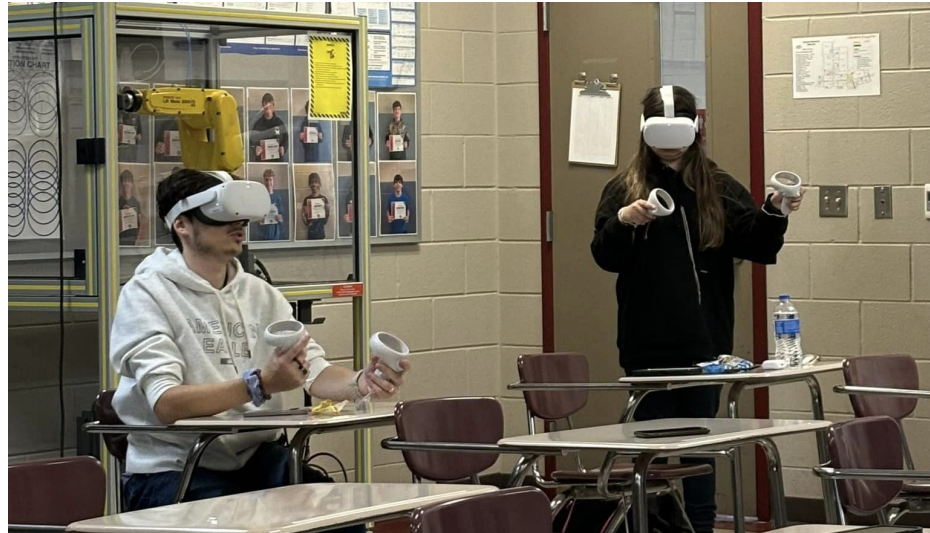
