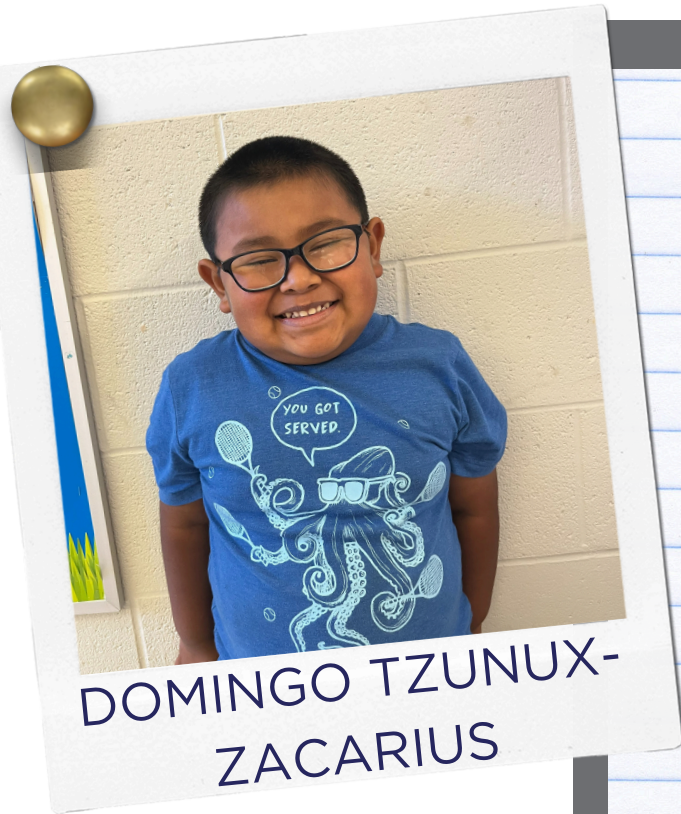

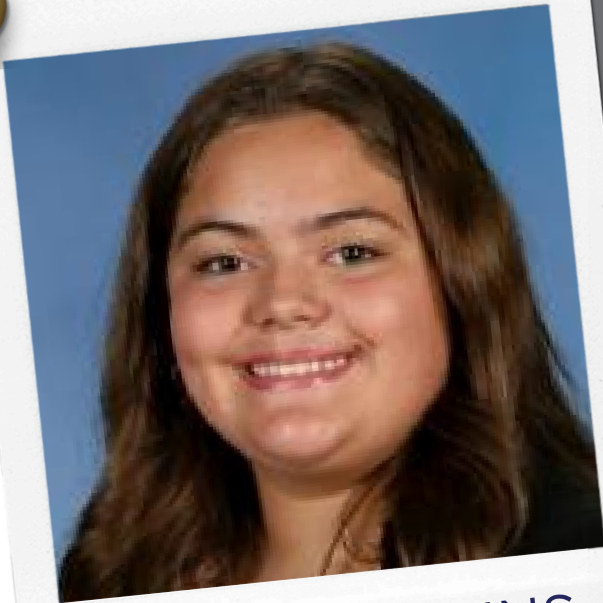

Anna is a wonderful student who always gives 110% each and every day. It has been a privilege to have her this year and watch her continue to grow as a student. - Mr. Paden

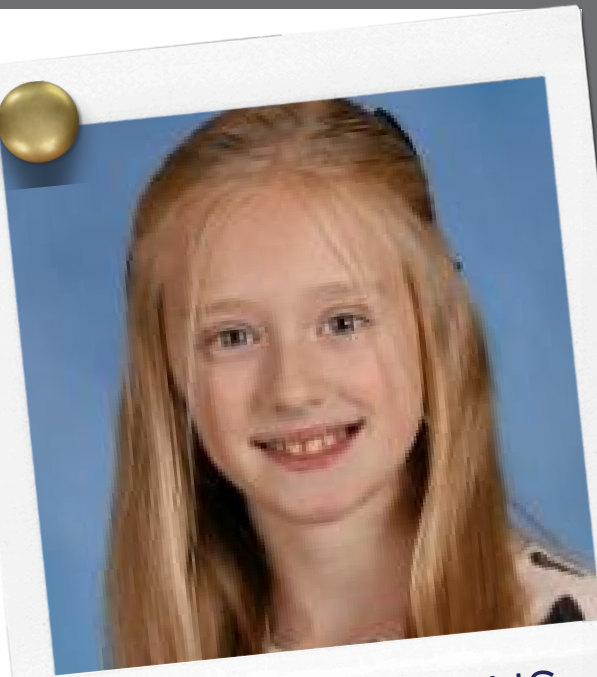
