

Mr. Dominic McCamish, Principal of Specialized Programs, is requesting to increase the extended days for the Assistant Principal from ten(10) to twenty-three (23) for the 2024-2025 school year. This addition of extended days would be consistent with the other high school assistant principals and would allow the administration at BAC/Riverview/SM to continue to support the needs of each of their students. GMA (Title 1 Part D Subpart 2) funds will be utilized to pay for the additional extended days.

RE: GMAP funds for Assistant Principal Extended Days for the 2024-2025 school year

<u>REQUEST</u>: I am requesting to allocate GMAP (Title 1 Part D Subpart 2) funds to pay for our Assistant Principal (Chadwick Golladay) to work 13 additional extended days during the 2024-2025 school year.

- Currently the BAC/Riverview Assistant Principal works 10 extended days. The additional 13 days would put them at 23 extended days.
- The other High School Assistant Principals in the district work 23 extended days. This
 will allow our High School Assistant Principal's position to be equitable with the other
 High School Assistant Principal positions.
- These additional Assistant Principal extended days will allow us to develop, implement, and continue systems of support to ensure all BAC/ROC/SM students are successful. It will also allow the Assistant Principal to be present during the summer school dates that are required by DJJ and KECSAC.
