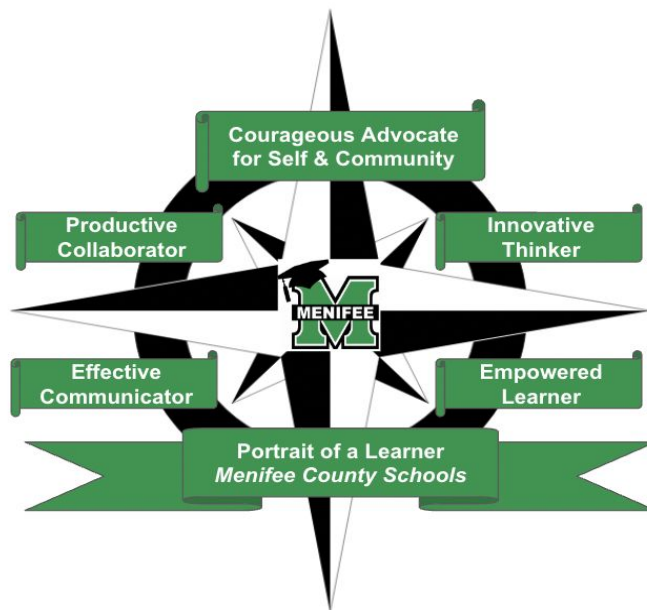

- Students in grades K-7 have completed the first iReady Diagnostic for Reading and Math.
 - Each student iReady pathway has been developed & students will receive supports based on their needs
