APPLICABLE STATUTE OR REGULATION:

KRS 165.010, 156.035, 20 U.S.C. 6320, 20 U.S.C. 7844. 20 U.S.C. 7883

BACKGROUND:

Existing Policy:

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 and its successors require the Kentucky Department of Education to adopt written procedures for the receipt and resolution of complaints alleging violations of law in the administration of programs under the ESEA.

Summary of Issue:

704 KAR 3:365 is being amended to conform with changes to federal regulation. The amendment provides greater clarity on the required elements of complaints and determination reports.

Budget Impact:

This regulation has no budget implications for the KDE, KBE, or local education agencies.

GROUPS CONSULTED AND BRIEF SUMMARY OF RESPONSES:

The regulation will go before the Local Superintendents Advisory Council (LSAC) at its September 24, 2024 meeting.
