This is our annual KETS (Kentucky Educational Technology Systems) Technology Activity Report. For school year 23-24, the district spent \$4,885,308.03 on technology-related expenses across departments and schools. Highlights include:

- Student Workstations- \$1,181,972.96 (this includes Chromebook purchases/leases. desktops and laptops).
- Faculty and Staff Workstations- \$534,317.28
- Administrative and Instructional Software- \$1,942,638.49 (this includes iReady, Edgenuity, Naviance, Fastbridge, etc)
- Classroom Hardware-\$579,421.16 (TVs, touchscreen interactive TVs, Chromeboxes, Document cameras, etc.)
- People Side of Education- \$1,273,754.96 (Director of Technology, Computer) Technicians, Digital Learning Coaches, STCs, Access 24 Site Coordinators, etc)
