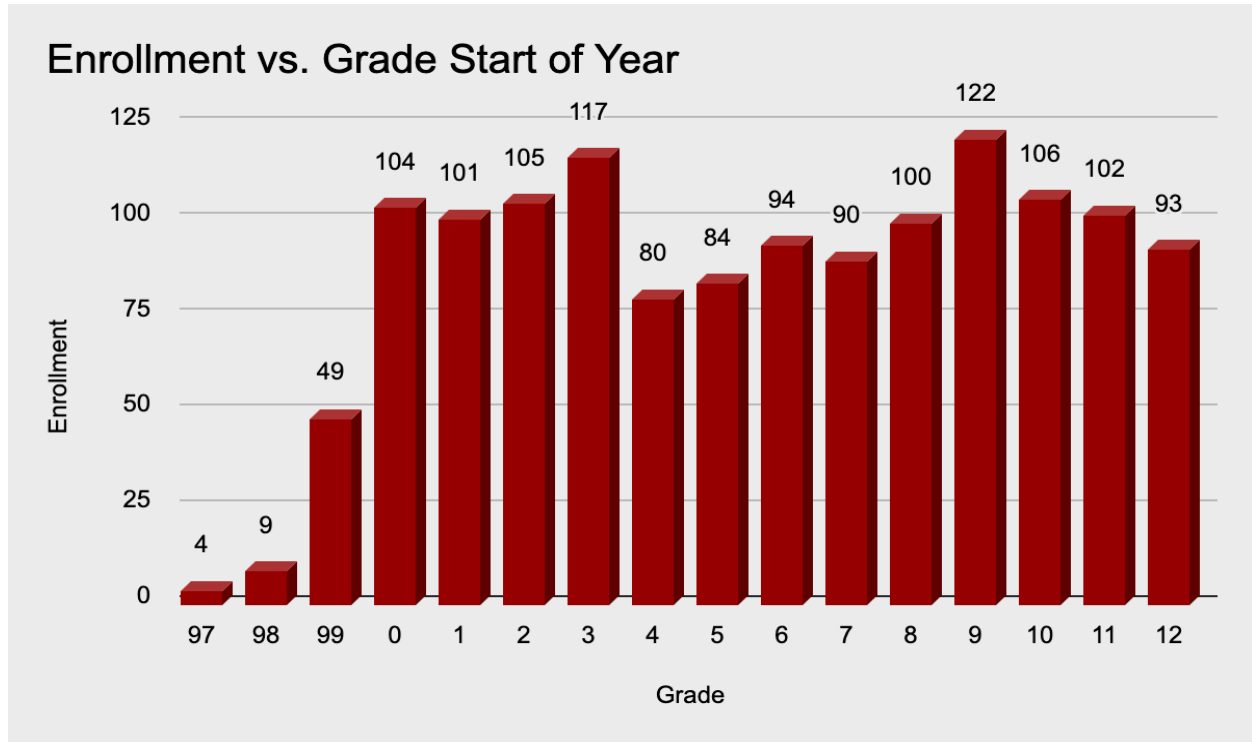

**Federal Programs**

The Consolidated Application for Title programs has been submitted and will be reviewed by the Kentucky Department of Education. Each school completed a needs assessment for Title I, II, and IV based on school data through the living needs assessment. Title III was completed at the district level based on input from a teacher survey, EL parent input, and EL teacher feedback of needs. The district has also submitted the Title I- Part D Performance Report for review. Newport Regional School utilizes Title I- Part D.

We have three private schools that have chosen to participate in Title I as one private school did not have students attending that would generate funds. Schools participating include: Holy Trinity, Newport Central Catholic, and Saint Therese. Each school has worked with the DPP to complete Equitable Service Agreements and these agreements are

### **English Language Learners Program**

There are currently 166 students qualifying for the EL program. We have one EL teacher at NPS with 61 students, one EL teacher at NIS with 44 students, and one EL teacher at NHS. We also have one EL teacher at NHS working with all EL teachers in the district as well as serving our Newcomers program. Students being served in grades 7-12 by EL teachers is 55. This does include students at NRS and NSOI. A special thank you to Mrs. Calderon for her work in preparing student learning plans and coordinating an EL Family Night in September. This team screened and completed a data analysis shared with each individual family for all 166 students.

### **Out of School Services (OOSS)**

Extended School Services and 21st Century began on September 4, 2024. There are currently openings at NHS and NPS for students and families wanting to engage in after school programming. NIS has had overwhelming family support and does have a few spots remaining in the 21st Century. Each site coordinator is currently working with school staff to identify and invite families who may benefit from this type of service. We have identified Friday transportation as a barrier to student engagement in Out of School Services and are working on a solution. Newport provides bus transportation on Monday through Thursday for those attending OOSS. Transportation is not available on Fridays as we do not currently have an extra driver or bus available during the regular dismissal time. Extended School Services has a KDE approved plan for the 24-25 School Year. Newport Intermediate will be utilizing a daytime waiver. All schools utilize ESS services in conjunction with 21st Century.
