PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Department walkthroughs began in the schools on September 17th and run through October 23rd. All academic departments throughout the district participate in walkthroughs.
- Attended a training on federal programs and federal spending in Lexington on September 10th.
- Districtwide vertical meetings occurred for most academic departments on September 11th allowing intentional time for teachers from both Lincoln and DHS to collaborate. The primary focus of these meetings was the various forms of writing that occur within each content, particularly how our writing assessments mirror KSA writing assessments/tasks.

ASSESSMENT

- The Kentucky Department of Education statewide “Quality Control Day” was on September 19th. Assessment data, including overall scoring and school “color” ratings, were released to school leadership. This data is embargoed until it can be shared with school staff on October 1st and embargoed from the public until October 3rd. All members of the leadership team that have seen/discussed this data have signed non-disclosure agreements.
- STAR Assessments have been completed in both buildings. Lincoln began MAP testing the week of 9/23.

OTHER TOPICS OF INTEREST

- Three weeks of districtwide vocabulary have been utilized in our classes and shared with the public. Feedback has been overwhelmingly positive thus far.
- We have continued to work with parochial schools that children living within our district boundaries attend to spend their federal Title I funds.
