The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session with all members present. Superintendent Schlosser welcomed everyone to the meeting. Mr. Schlosser again said that the school year was off to a great start, and that we are two weeks away from fall break. Dr. Milli McIntosh was recognized by Mr. Schlosser for being named Human Resources Director of the year at the KASHRM Conference.
