

Areas of improvement by location

- No CSI Schools
- GOS - Above the state average indicator score for Reading and Math
- GOS - Above the state average indicator score for Science, Social Studies, Combined Writing
- GOS - Above the state average for overall indicator score
- GOS improved in Science from 49% to 52%
- GOS continues to be our highest performing elementary school in terms of Proficient and Distinguished students in all of the following content areas: Reading, Math, Science, Editing and Mechanics, on-Demand Writing, and Combined Writing.
- JGC - above the state average indicator score for EL students
- JGC is our highest performing elementary school in Social Studies at 45% proficient and distinguished.
- LES - above the state average indicator score for Reading and Math
- LES - Above the state average for overall indicator score
- LES improved in Reading from 48% to 60%
- LES improved math proficiency from 32% to 45%
- LES improved social studies proficiency from 13% to 34%
- LES improved in Editing and Mechanics from 64% to 73%
- LES improved in combined writing from 51% to 53%
- Ninth District – Improves overall index
- Ninth District - Above the state average indicator score for Science, Social Studies, Combined Writing
- Ninth District improved in Reading from 23% to 31%
- Ninth District improved in Math from 16 to 22%
- Ninth District improved in Social Studies from 13% to 34%
- Ninth District improved editing and mechanics proficiency from 15% to 29%
- Ninth District improved in Combined Writing from 3% to 20%

- Sixth District improved reading proficiency from 34% to 38%

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- HMS Moved out of TSI Status – Hispanic students
 - HMS improved math proficiency from 19% to 22%
 - HMS improved science proficiency from 5% to 11%
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- HHS came out of TSI Status for one of their two areas - out for Hispanic, still in for Special Ed
 - HHS Third year in a row of HHS improvements
 - HHS / Improved Overall Index
 - HHS - above the state average indicator score for Postsecondary Readiness
 - HHS - above the state average indicator score for Graduation Rate
 - HHS improved reading proficiency from 18% to 28%
 - HHS improved math proficiency from 9% to 18%
 - HHS improved social studies proficiency from 15% to 17%
 - HHS improved on-demand writing from 19% to 22%
 - HHS improved from combined writing from 19% to 21%
 - HHS Graduation Rate Improved - 4 Year 91.9 from 83.2, 5 Year 86.2 from 84.4
 - HHS Post Secondary Readiness Improved. $140 / 203 = 69\%$ from 45%, 52% the previous 2 years.
