



PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT
Between
The COLLABORATIVE FOR TEACHING AND LEARNING and
RUSSELLVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS
July 2024 – June 2025

This agreement, between the Collaborative for Teaching and Learning (CTL) and Russellville Independent Schools, describes the programmatic and financial commitments made to advance the district's goal of increasing high-quality literacy experiences in the home in preschool through grade 8 through participation in the Innovative Approaches to Literacy (IAL) grant.

Russellville Independent Schools will:

- Identify and coordinate participating teachers, and oversee all communications within the schools
- Maintain communications with CTL to identify and respond to ongoing needs of project participants
- Provide for any logistical, support, or participant expenses not covered in the fees and description provided here (see possible costs below)
- Communicate to participating faculty accountability for implementation of new learning to improve professional practice

This agreement covers work to be accomplished between July 1, 2024, and June 30, 2025, and may be amended to include additional services. CTL will invoice Russellville Independent Schools quarterly, beginning at the inception of work, with payment due within 30 days.
