GMS had an exceptional year, increasing in all academic indicators. The school achieved a green rating in reading and math, with an 8.1-point jump in those areas, and saw a 14.7-point increase in science, social studies, and writing. Overall, GMS grew by 10.7 points, bringing them within just 2.1 points of achieving a green overall rating. Importantly, the school also exited its Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) classification.

The high school showed growth in school climate, safety, and graduation rates. They maintained a blue status in the postsecondary readiness indicator but experienced a decline in core academic performance, which will be a key focus for improvement moving forward.
