







What We Did: Inquiry -Based Project



Driving Question:

 How can we educate our Mustangs to safely walk and ride bikes & scooters around town?

Supporting Question:

 How can we keep ourselves and others safe while riding our bikes on the sidewalk?

Our Ideas:

- Appropriate riding speeds
- Be aware of your surroundings
- Always wear a helmet and appropriate clothing
- Be extra safe around driveways

Mrs. Van Orsdel's Class



Supporting Question:

 What is the best and safest way to walk your bike across the streets or intersections?



- Always use the crosswalk & walk your bike/scooter
- Eye contact & communication with drivers
- Look both ways (multiple times)
- Slow down when approaching an intersection
- Walk your wheels.

Ms. Hils' Class



Supporting Question:

 How can we improve the way we walk on the sidewalk so it's safer?



Our Ideas:

- Putting phones & distractions away
- Communication use manners: excuse me, please, thank you when passing
- Share the sidewalk with other pedestrians
- Stay alert!

Mrs. Posinski's Class



Supporting Question:

 How can we safely cross the street to avoid getting hurt by moving vehicles?



- Always use the crosswalk.
- If there is a button, push it and wait.
- Make eye contact with a driver and wait for their signal to cross.
- Cross in a group, if possible.






