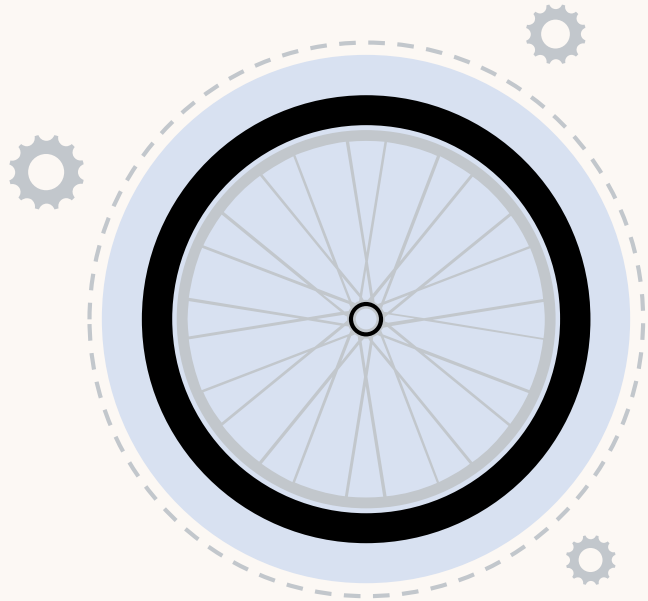




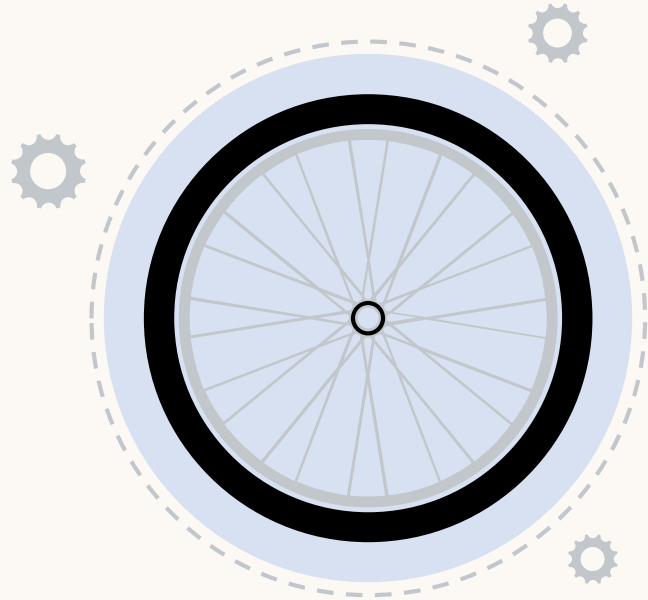

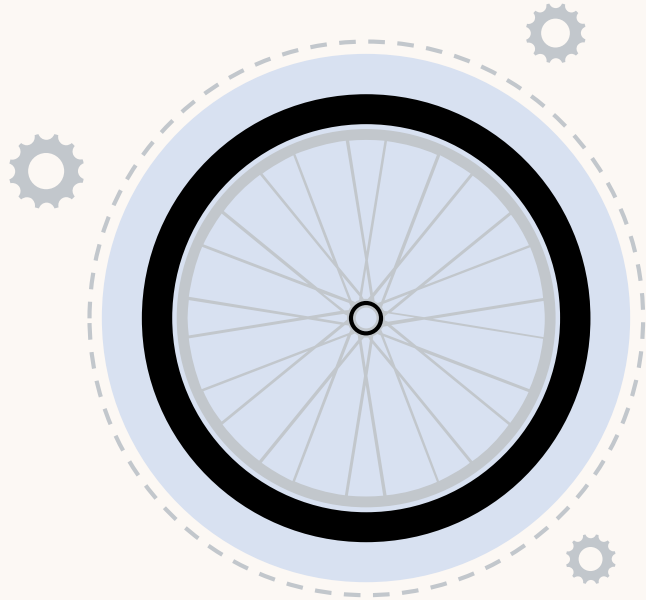


What We Did: *Inquiry -Based Project*

Our Ideas:

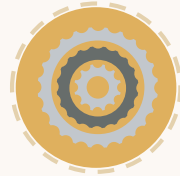
- Always use the crosswalk & walk your bike/scooter

Our Ideas:

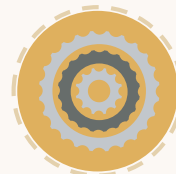
- Putting phones & distractions away

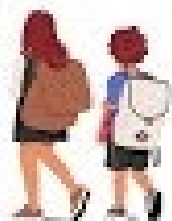
Supporting Question:

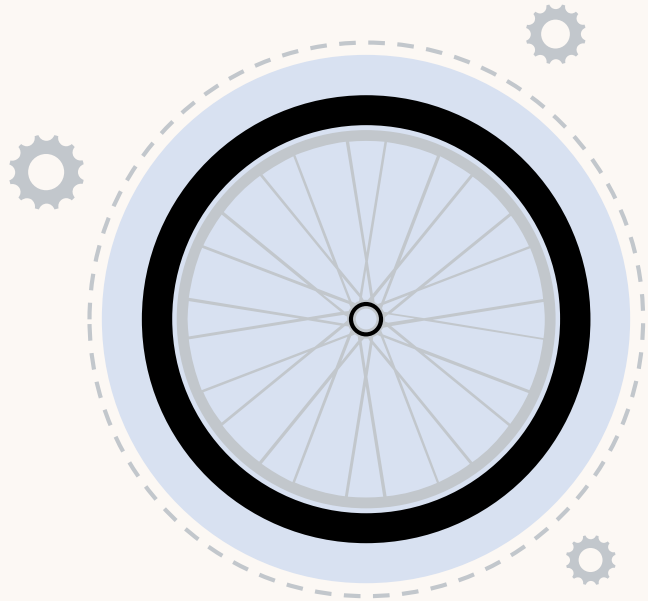

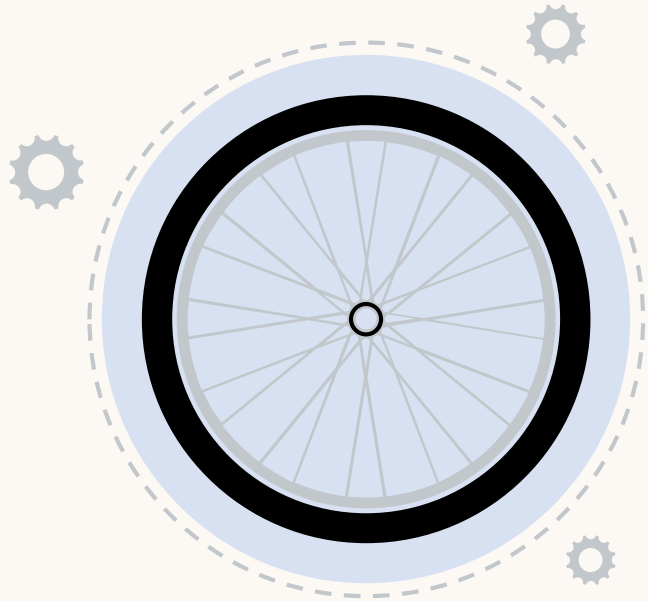
