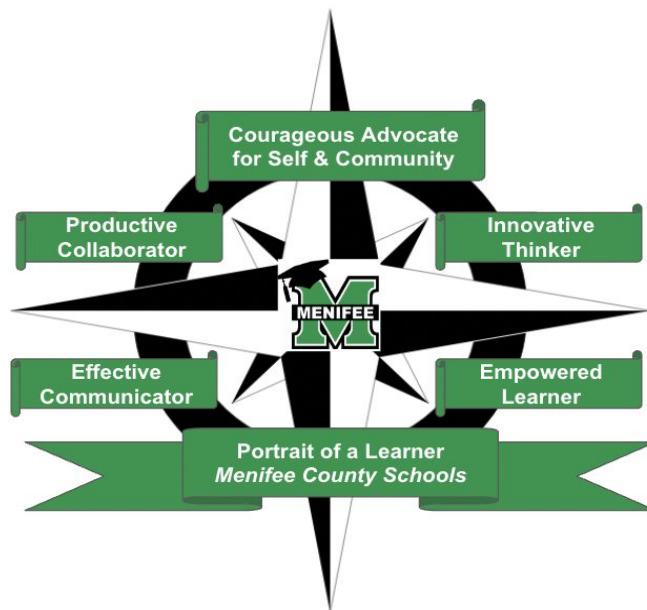

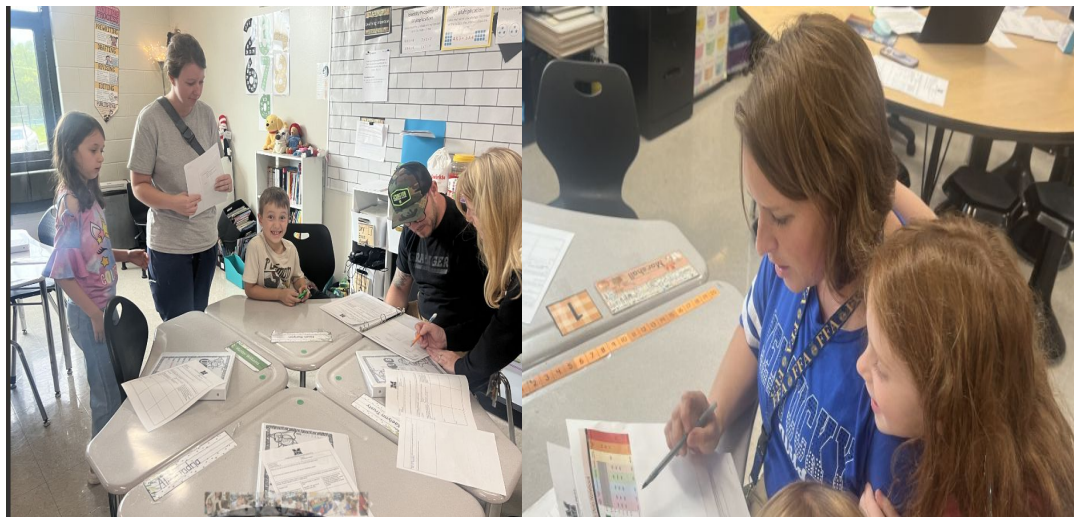

Meniffee County High School Instructional Initiatives

MCCHS and the Kentucky Writing Project have partnered to implement focused writing practices in all classrooms to effectively support teachers in enhancing their reading and writing instructional practices. Our goal is to embed literacy practices in all content areas, including CTE, where students are writing in each class, every day. We have purchased composition notebooks for each student, through PRI. Our teachers have had professional development on the “notice and wonder” and “talk to the text” strategies. We are looking forward to learning more about and implementing our next strategy, “they say, I say” on our October 22nd professional development day with the Kentucky Writing Project.
